Participants had the opportunity to engage with specialists, ask questions, and receive guidance on how to respond to potential violations of their rights.

INFO-RIGHTS also announced the upcoming release of an interactive digital guide, designed to provide workers with detailed information on labor conditions, social security, and administrative procedures across various EU countries.
